The Technical Committee and the Competition Committee of UEIL are pleased to advise its members that, PSA Purchasing Executive Manager, Mr. Jérôme BOULET, has recently confirmed that:

"Peugeot and Citroën dealers are allowed to use lubricants which are not approved by PSA so long as the quality is equivalent to the approved products and so long as it is dedicated to a paying maintenance or service and not to any work under car maker warranty; such a use would not question the carmaker warranty so long as such lubricants, of an equivalent quality, do not present any defect and do not cause any dysfunction of the vehicles."
